12. INSURANCE

By endorsing the application form for entry, the FMN of the rider certifies that the rider is insured in accordance with the FIM requirements.

The organiser has contracted a third party insurance in accordance with Art. 110.1.2 of the FIM Sporting Code.

This insurance includes a guarantee of: 20'000'000 NUK

The organiser disclaims all responsibility for damage to a snowmobile, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other incident.

13. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Any person or group of persons (rider, entrant, manufacturer, official, etc.), recognised by the FIM and concerned by a decision taken under the authority of the FIM, may ask for redress for the consequences of that decision.

Protests may be lodged to the Race Direction according to the FIM Disciplinary and Arbitration Code and be accompanied by applicable deposit of € 660.- or the equivalent amount in local currency, returnable if the protest is justified.

An appeal against the decision of the Race Direction may be lodged to the FIM Stewards Panel. This appeal must be presented 30 minutes at the latest after the notification of that decision and must be accompanied by a deposit of € 1'320.- or the equivalent amount in local currency, returnable if the appeal is justified.

An appeal against the decision of the FIM Stewards Panel may be lodged to the CDI. This appeal must be presented 5 days at the latest after the notification of the FIM Stewards Panel's decision (Security deposit for appeal: € 1'320.-).

Generally, protests against the eligibility of a rider, entrant or a motorcycle entered, must be made before the start of the official practice.

Any other protests must be lodged immediately after the reason for the protest is known.

Protests against results must be presented to the Race Direction within 30 minutes following the announcement of the results.

If the protest entails dismantling a motorcycle, the protest fee must be accompanied by an additional deposit of € 120.-. This fee must be paid by the losing party to the mechanic of the rider who had to open the engine.

Protests entailing a fuel control must be accompanied by an additional deposit of € 800.-

14. TRAVEL INDEMNITIES AND PRIZES






Arriving at Kirkenes



You will be met by parking guards. They will guide you to the welcome office. The welcome office will be open Thursday from 0900 am and is in same building as Race Direction Office. There you need to do the registration and pay the inscription fee that is 140,- Euros. Payment can be done by credit card. The inscription fee covers the athlete and two mechanics. Other team members will have to buy an ordinary ticket fee.

After registration you will be guided to your parking area in the paddock.

Paddock

Paddock will be open from Thursday 14:00. The Paddock official and he's crew will guide you to your spot.

There is only space for one vehicle and paddock tent for each team.


Additional vehicles will have to park at the parking B area according to the situation plan.

There will be 230V electricity for the teams in the Paddock. You need to bring your own extension cable and socket. You also need a minimum of 6 kg fire extinguisher. The fire extinguisher will have to be visible at your paddock space during the whole stay.

All competitors that aren't competing Sunday, needs to exit the paddock area after the WC/EC races are over. We appreciate that this is prioritized. This is to make room for the Sunday race competitors. You will be able to park your vehicle in the arena area until Sunday if you wish. Such arrangement can be done with the paddock official.

Camp for trailers

If additional caravan or camping van space, with electricity is needed, it can be booked at the [spectators camp](#) or bought during check in.

Race day

Equipment

All riders need to make sure that their safety equipment is according to the rules and regulations. Also remember to check that your number plates on snowmobile, and numbers on all of your jersey's, is according to regulations.

Changing room and SPA

There are two changing rooms in the same building as the race office/race direction office. Each of the changing rooms have one shower. There is a possibility to go to the [Kirkenes SPA](#) located according to the "accommodation and service" map. There is an entry fee of 90,- NOK to use those facility's. This is a discounted price that you get when showing your competitor's card/accreditation or ticket armband. The SPA is open until 20:30 on Friday, and 19:00 on Saturday.

Banquet including dinner

The Banquet dinner will be between 19:00 and 21:00, Saturday. Drinks can be bought. Tickets for the banquet can be bought at the welcome office at check in. The location is marked on the "accommodation and service" map.

Price giving ceremony after banquet

After the banquet there will be a secondary ceremony for the top 3 in each class. This ceremony is on Saturday during afterparty.
